

Prices for educational IT software installation services generally follow three pricing structures: hourly-based technical support (\$145 to \$250 per hour), per-device deployment fees (\$26 to \$82 per endpoint), or comprehensive monthly Managed IT contracts (\$200 to \$250 per user). Educational facilities (K-12 schools, charter programs, and universities) typically qualify for academic tier breaks and volume discounts on implementation. [1, 2, 3, 4, 5]
The standard price lists below are broken down by project type, deployment method, and recurring support:



1. Hourly & Project-Based Installation Rates

For standalone or ad-hoc software rollouts—such as deploying a new Learning Management System (LMS) or updating computer lab operating systems—IT service providers bill by technical specialty tiers.

Service Tier	Hourly Rate (Avg)	Typical Scope / Use Case in Schools
<u>Desktop & Lab Support</u>	\$145 / hr	Individual PC/Mac software installation, endpoint configurations, and peripheral setup.
<u>General IT & Troubleshooting</u>	\$125 – \$200 / hr	Resolving application software conflicts, localized server issues, and basic patch fixes.
Cloud Deployment & Migration	\$150 – \$250 / hr	Setting up cloud-hosted school management platforms, student databases, and remote software access portals.
Network & Server Tech Support	\$200 / hr	Enterprise-wide central software deployments, provisioning virtual machines, and network configuration.
Premier / Security Consulting	\$250 / hr	Integrating identity management (Active Directory) and ensuring FERPA / COPPA student privacy compliance.
